Youth Ministry Highlight - "Rise Student Ministry" 7th grade and up

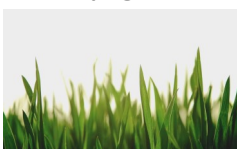

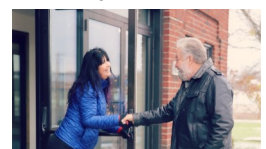

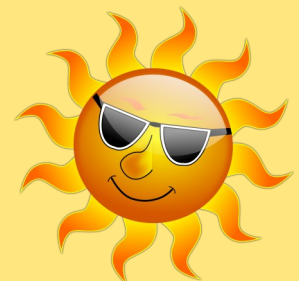
